## What is the Cadetship in Road Transport?

It's a 12-week quality training programme that will give you all the skills and knowledge you need to start a career in truck driving:

- If you hold a Class 1 license, you can expect to gain your Class 2 license
- If you hold a Class 2 license can expect to gain your Class 4 license

## What does it involve?

The Cadetship programme is split into two parts:

1. For the first eight weeks, you will spend:

- One day at a Polytechnic
- One day doing your own study
- And three days working for a road transport operator

2. For the last four weeks, you will be full-time with a road transport operator, working and being assessed. You will have to successfully complete the first eight weeks before you move into full-time work placement.

## What will I learn?

The Cadetship programme covers:

- Class 2 or Class 4 drivers license tests and endorsement
- OSH forklift certificate
- Fatigue and logbook assessment
- Heavy motor vehicle start-up/shut down
- Customer service skills
- Loading and unloading a goods service vehicle
- Documentation for the transport of goods by road
- Personal presentation
- ACC Driver Safe
- Applied knowledge of manual handling of goods
- "D" (Dangerous Goods) test and endorsement (only in selected programmes)

## Who can apply?

You can apply if you are a school leaver, if you're considering a career change, or if you're already in the industry and want to further develop your skills.

## Before you can be accepted, you must:

- Complete a medical
- Complete a drugs test
- Have a police check (which is also required for you to be eligible for full-time employment)
- Complete an ARM risk and safety profile
- Own approved safety boots

## How much does it cost?

The programme fee is \$1000 +GST, which includes study guides, assessments and license endorsements. You may be eligible for a student loan to cover the course costs. You may also receive payment but this is a separate and optional arrangement with the operating company and is outside the scope of this programme.
